

Manothejaka, a helpline of the Department of Psychology, St Aloysius College (Autonomous) has been reaching out and offering support to people through counselling, networking, volunteering, peer counselling and fund raising.

As part of the COVID care of St Aloysius we are providing counselling support to those in need and conducting follow ups with those who have received financial, medical or Ration help. So far, the team has reached out to 66 families.

Partnered with Creative Dignity organization to provide psychological support to the village artisans across the country. Reached out to 144 artisans so far.


Psychological support is extended to 450 parents and students of Harihar Pre University College.
